Acadia University, founded in 1838, is a member of the Association of Atlantic Universities, of the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada and has the authority to offer courses and confer degrees in most branches of university work. The University offers enrolment in undergraduate and graduate programs in the Faculties of Arts, Professional Studies, Pure and Applied Sciences, and Theology.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The basis of admission is Nova Scotia Grade 12 Academic or its equivalent. Mature students are also admitted.

PROGRAMS

Bachelor of Applied Science, Bachelor of Theology - three years (90 hours). Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Computer Science, Bachelor of Science in Nutrition, Bachelor of Music, Bachelor of Kinesiology, and Bachelor of Community Development (formerly Recreation Management) - four years (120 hours). Bachelor of Education (post-baccalaureate) - (60 hours).

Certificate in Applied Science - two years (69 hours) leading to studies at Dalhousie University or another university offering the Bachelor of Engineering degree. Certificates in Computer Science (30 hours), Music Therapy (30 hours), and French Proficiency (30 hours).

Students can complete a range of disciplinary and multidisciplinary areas, as well as options in French or German proficiency.

Master of Arts, Master of Education, Master of Science, Master of Community Development (formerly Recreation Management), Master of Arts (Theology) Master of Divinity, Master of Theology, Doctor of Ministry, Doctor of Philosophy (Education).

Discontinued programs - (1989) Bachelor of Secretarial Administration - three years; Diploma in Secretarial Science - one year; (1987) Bachelor of Arts or Science in Recreation and Physical Education - four years; (1993) Bachelor of Science in Home Economics - four years; (1995) Bachelor of Arts - three years; (1997) Master of Religious Education - two years; (1999) Bachelor of Food Science - four years.

CREDIT HOURS

One credit hour approximates one scheduled hour per week per term. Laboratory work, tutorials, and other required activities are additional and without credit.

COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM

The first digit indicates the year of normal registration. "1, 2, 3, 4" being self-explanatory. "4" also indicates courses taken in post-baccalaureate professional programs. "5, 6 and 7" courses at the graduate level, "8" professional

development courses, and "9" courses accepted for transfer credit without an Acadia equivalent. The middle digit (or digits) provide serial listings of courses offered at each level. In the fourth place, the digit "1" indicates a one credit hour course (1h), the digit "3" indicates a three credit hour course (3h), the digit "6" indicates a six credit hour (6h) course, and the digit "0" indicates a non-credit course. An alpha character indicates a non-standard credit value. Laboratory hours are additional.
