### Explanatory Notes

This is an International Certificate of Education (ICE) statement of results. The University of Cambridge International Examinations reserves the right to amend the information on this statement. Results will be confirmed by the issue of certificates.

Distinction, Merit or Pass will be awarded to candidates who meet the requirements of ICE. Only individual syllabus results for the final session are reported on this statement of results. Therefore not all of the counting syllabuses used to determine ICE are shown for candidates taking ICE over two sessions.

International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) results are reported on an 8-point scale of grades: A\*(a\*), A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), F(f) or G(g), grade A\*(a\*) being the highest and grade G(g) the lowest. UNGRADED indicates a standard below that required for grade G(g).

General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level (GCE O Level) results are reported on a 6-point scale of grades: A\*(a\*), A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d) or E(e), grade A\*(a\*) being the highest and grade E(e) the lowest. UNGRADED indicates a standard below that required for grade E(e).

NO RESULT indicates that a result cannot be issued because of absence for the whole or part of the examination in the syllabus or because of a decision not to issue a result for some other reason.

PENDING indicates that a result cannot be issued at present but will follow in due course.

TO BE ISSUED indicates that the results will be issued in the next session.

The assessment of Oral/Aural communication is compulsory in IGCSE English as a Second Language syllabus 0510 and 0511. In IGCSE First Language syllabuses and Afrikaans as a Second Language syllabus 0548 the assessment of Speaking & Listening communication is optional. Except for IGCSE English as a Second Language syllabus 0511, these components are assessed separately and the results are reported on a 5-point numerical scale, grade 1(ONE) being the highest and grade 5(FIVE) the lowest. Candidates who fail to reach the minimum standard for grade 5(FIVE) will not receive an Oral/Aural (Speaking & Listening) communication endorsement. The endorsement grade for Oral/Aural (Speaking & Listening) communication will be reported on IGCSE certificates provided the overall IGCSE syllabus result in the subject concerned is grade G(g) or higher.

The Percentage Uniform Mark for IGCSE and GCE O Level is provided in addition to the grade for a syllabus. The Percentage Uniform Mark is not the total mark achieved for the syllabus. It is a common scale for all syllabuses to show whether the candidate's performance is close to the top, bottom or middle of the grade. We do not provide a Percentage Uniform Mark where the candidate's result is Ungraded, No Result, Pending or To Be Issued.

Only grades A\*(a\*) to G(g) achieved in IGCSE and A\*(a\*) to E(e) in GCE O Level syllabuses will be reported on certificates.

Only Distinction, Merit and Pass achieved in the ICE Award will be reported on certificates.
