Students entering between Fall 1999 to Fall 2010 who achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.15 were considered to be in good academic standing unless otherwise noted. Students entering prior to Fall 1999 who achieved a cumulative GPA of 2.00 were considered to be in good standing.
