Case Study II Results

Case study II results have been finalised and approved by the core committee. Your mark for Case study II was **6.5** which is graded as **Competent**.

Below is an evaluation of your paper by the examiner.

Not really the form of a professional advice to client. Some recognition of issues and potential solutions on the commercia; level but somewhat garbled, no clear distinction between entities, stakeholder positions. Good analysis of key WHOA jurisdiction, recognition points. But only for BV? How about the other entities? Also on ch 15 jurisdiction: but all with limited explanation/background (material).

Good use of Deibold Nixdorf precedent. Good pickup on FIA licenses as key assets. Very good catch on EIR recognition exception for employee rights. References to Restructuring Directive on point. Relevant cites. No full pickup on missing information (governing laws of loans, ...).

Not a full-fledged analysis on (actual) recognition of the various proceedings given the jurisdictional bases thereof against the facts. Lacks some clarity overall, also as to overall plan/how to implement KuasaNas deal and on position, interests of various stakeholders. No (real/explicit) pickup on (local) director's (liability) issues. No (full) regard for FIA licenses, revenues etc. as key assets, possible impact of restructuring.
